



The Dental Hygiene degree program aims to train dental hygienists who are clinically competent to provide dental hygiene care and assess the dental hygiene needs of individuals of all ages, creating health appropriate oral education promotion and interventions.

The skills acquired in the course should also enable the dental hygienist to have an active intervention in society, in the scientific and in the professional community, as well as with policy makers, thus contributing to the improvement of oral health of the population and the national health system.

MAIN GOALS

At the end of the course students should have the knowledge and skills that will enable them to contribute to improving the oral health of the population and the oral health system.

The objectives of this cycle of studies are:

- To train professionals with a broad set of knowledge, skills and attitudes that give them the competences for the exercise of Dental Hygiene in Portugal and in Europe;
- To educate and train in Health Sciences, fundamental to the understanding of human development and the causes of diseases;
- To provide the development of skills in dental hygienist-patient communication, in its personal, family and social dimension;
- To enable Dental Hygienists to provide oral health care based on scientific evidence in various contexts and directed to different population groups
- Provide the acquisition of clinical skills in the field of dental hygienist;
- Train professionals with solid scientific training and technical competence that allows the construction of autonomy, which promotes a reflective professional practice and fosters lifelong learning.



Attendance of the Degree in Hygiene provides the Dental student with professional and scientific based education, developed in a dynamic learning environment that encourages collaboration between students and teachers

The training of the Degree in Dental Hygiene allows its students to:

- Participate in oral health education programs and raise awareness of oral disease prevention.
- Participate in the planning, implementation and evaluation of public health programs.
- Perform clinical treatments for the prevention and control of gingivitis, periodontitis and dental caries.
