GENERAL OBJECTIVES

Clinic

- To have a global vision of the different disabilities, including legal, psychosocial, educational, political, economic and architectural aspects;
- To prepare individualized plans, adapted to each situation and determine the need for referencing and referral;
- To develop competences for the provision of oral hygiene care to people with special needs;

Community

 To program community intervention protocols in oral health and functional applicability of new techniques, procedures and methodologies in the provision of oral hygiene care;

Research

To develop a research project in institutions for people with disabilities



By the end of the program, oral health professionals should have the ability to produce new knowledge and develop new skills in the area of oral health for people with disabilities.

Oral health professionals are also expected to be able to master the pedagogical techniques of presenting topics in public in order to allow them to participate in the education of individuals and community as well as scientific trainings.

RULES OF OPERATION

TARGET AUDIENCE:

Holders of a degree in Oral Hygiene or in Dental Medicine or legal equivalent;

Holders of an academic, scientific or professional curriculum recognized by the Scientific Council of the FMDUL as attesting to their capacity to carry out the course

QUALIFICATION:

Certificate of registration designated Diploma, according to Decree-Law No. 115/2013 of 7 August.

ACCREDITATION & DURATION:

30 ECTS | 1 year October to July.

TYPOLOGY OF CLASSES:

Face-to-face and online with lectures, seminars and clinical practice.

COST:

1500 € (may change)

SCHEDULE:

12 hours per week on days to be designated.

Admission to the Postgraduate Programme is subject to the regulations set by the university and to the calendar and number of vacancies fixed annually.

When the candidate has all the necessary documentation in his/her possession, the selection process will begin:

EVALUATION METHODOLOGIES

The assessment in the different curricular units is based on continuous assessment according to the following criteria:

- Participation and assiduity in classes;
- Relationship with patients, teachers and auxiliary staff;
- Evaluation of work performed;
- Application of knowledge in clinical practice;
- Presentation and discussion of clinical cases;
- · Review and discussion of scientific papers.

The final classification of the course is the average, weighted by the respective number of credit units.
